

INFORMATION OBLIGATION CLAUSE

LUX MED Ubezpieczenia Towarzystwo Ubezpieczeń i Reasekuracji S.A.

Below, you will find all necessary information concerning the processing of your data as part of our business relationship, in particular for the purpose of contracting and facilitating business contacts.

Who is the controller of your data?	Your personal data processed for the purpose of providing insurance coverage to you is controlled by LUX MED Ubezpieczenia Towarzystwo Ubezpieczeń i Reasekuracji S.A., with its registered office at ul. Szturmowa 2, 02-678 Warsaw, entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register by the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw, 13th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under KRS number 0001192054, Tax ID No (NIP): 5214131363, (hereinafter referred to as “we”, “Insurer” or “LUX MED Ubezpieczenia”).	
Who can I contact regarding the processing of personal data?	In all matters relating to the processing of your personal data by LUX MED Ubezpieczenia, you can contact our Data Protection Officer, by writing to the e-mail address: daneosobowe@luxmed.pl .	
What is the source of my data – where is the data obtained from?	Your personal data is made available directly by you, or by your employer, or by the entity you represent. In some cases, your data may be also obtained from publicly available sources, such as the National Court Register (KRS) or the Central Register and Information on Economic Activity (CEIDG).	
What is the scope of my personal data processed by LUX MED Ubezpieczenia?	We process your personal data such as: name, surname, telephone number, e-mail address, position, name and registered office of the entity you represent. If you are a representative or a governing body member of a business partner of LUX MED Ubezpieczenia, a partner in a civil law partnership or a self-employed natural person, LUX MED Ubezpieczenia may process your personal data in a broader scope, including also the Personal ID Number (PESEL) and any other personal data contained in public registers and in the submitted power of attorney.	
What is the purpose and legal basis for the processing of my personal data?	Purpose of processing	Legal basis (full names of the legal acts can be found at the end of the form)
	We contact you regarding current matters or respond to questions or concerns you have addressed to us. Usually, we do this in the performance of a contract between LUX MED Ubezpieczenia and your employer or the entity you represent.	Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, as the so-called legitimate interest of the controller, which is to ensure contact in current matters associated with the business activity of LUX MED Ubezpieczenia.
	If you are a self-employed natural person or a partner in a civil law partnership, we process your data for the purpose of concluding and performing a contract, including as part of settlements and ongoing exchange of business correspondence.	Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR, i.e. performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party, or taking steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract.
	As a data controller being an entrepreneur, we have the right to pursue and defend claims related to our business activity and, therefore, to process your data for this purpose.	Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, as the so-called legitimate interest of the controller, which is the pursuit of our claims and protection of our rights.
	As an entrepreneur, we also keep accounting books and have tax obligations – we issue invoices for the services we render, which may necessitate the processing of your personal data.	Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR, i.e. compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject (e.g. under tax law)
	Since we are in a constant economic relationship with you, we may, as part of our collaboration, send you information about our activities, offers or opportunities to collaborate with LUX MED Ubezpieczenia.	Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, as the so-called legitimate interest of the controller, which is to build and maintain relationships with our business partners.
Who will receive my personal data?	Due to the need to ensure the proper organisation of our enterprise, e.g. the functioning of IT infrastructure or handling on-going matters relating to our business activity, your personal data may be transferred to the following categories of recipients: 1. entities providing LUX MED Ubezpieczenia with technical and organisational solutions that enable us to fulfil our obligations and manage our organisation (in particular, ICT service providers, courier and postal companies), 2. providers of legal and advisory services and services supporting LUX MED Ubezpieczenia in pursuing due claims (in particular law firms, debt collection companies).	

Is my data transferred outside the European Union?	Due to the fact that we use services of other entities (e.g. providers of e-mail services), your personal data may be transferred outside the European Economic Area (which includes the EU Member States, Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein). We assure you that in such a case, the data will be transferred on the basis of the relevant agreement concluded between LUX MED Ubezpieczenia and the respective entity, containing standard data protection clauses adopted by the European Commission, or on the basis of the European Commission's adequacy decision pertaining to personal data protection.
How long is my personal data processed for?	We process your personal data for the period of our collaboration or the collaboration between LUX MED Ubezpieczenia and your employer or the entity you represent and, after its termination, for the period of limitation of claims. If your personal data was processed as part of LUX MED Ubezpieczenia's compliance with its legal obligations – for a period specified in the law. After the expiry of the aforementioned periods, your data is permanently erased or anonymised.
Is the provision of data mandatory?	The provision of your data to us is voluntary. However, failure to provide data may render us unable to respond to your request or provide you with other content you have requested, and sometimes also prevent the conclusion of a contract with a business partner.
What rights do I have?	As a data controller, we guarantee you the right of access to your data, as well as the right of rectification, erasure or restriction of processing of your data. You also have the right to object to LUX MED Insurance's processing of your data and the right to transfer your data to another controller. If you wish to exercise any of these rights, please contact us at the address of our registered office or by e-mail: Also, please be advised that you have the right to file a complaint with the authority supervising compliance with personal data protection regulations.
